MARINE REPAIRS COMPLETED - 3Q 2021

N-KOM COMPLETES 2ND FSRU REPAIR



N-KOM has successfully completed drydocking and repairs for Floating Storage and Regasification Unit (FSRU) *Exquisite*. This is the second Excelerate Energy-owned FSRU to be repaired at N-KOM, with its sister vessel FSRU *Excelerate* repaired at the shipyard back in 2019.

Technically managed and operated by Nakilat, the 150,900cbm FSRU *Exquisite* underwent several major modifications including the retrofit and commissioning of a Ballast Water Treatment System (BWTS), overhauling of systems and equipments, upgrading, installation and testing works. It is noteworthy to highlight that the critical hydraulic tubing works on the vessel was completed on time with no leaks or rework required during the testing.

The achievement of high customer satisfaction ratings and encouraging feedback from our customer on the outstanding safety and quality execution of this project further underscores the technical competency and solid commitment of our team towards service excellence.

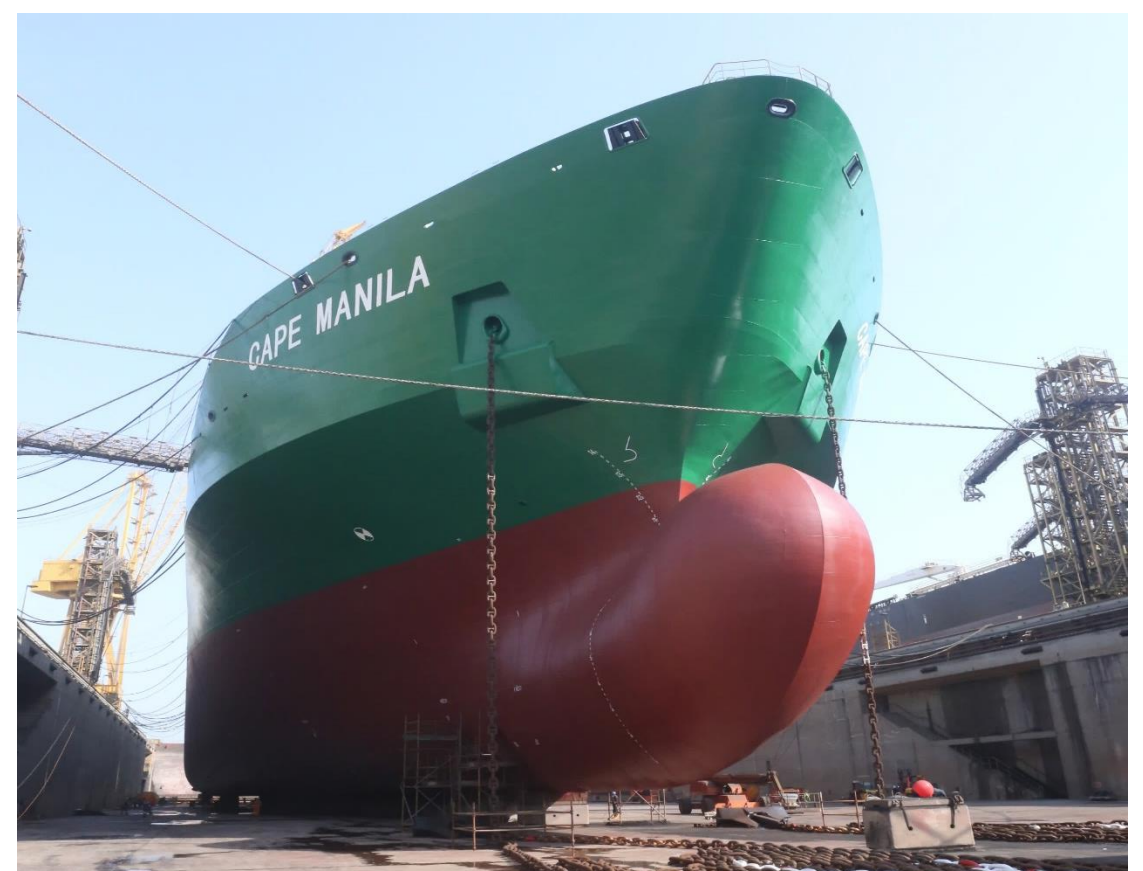
RECENT TANKER & CONTAINER VESSEL REPAIRS

During the past quarter, N-KOM has completed a number of drydocking and repairs for Tanker and Container vessels.

Repairs were safely completed for three Tankers from our regular Greek clients:

- **Maran Ariande** - Maran Tankers Management
- **Amazon Beauty** - Sun Enterprises
- **Sealuck III** - Eastern Mediterranean Maritime Limited

In addition, the 41,535dwt Container vessel **Cape Manila** from our new client Columbia Shipmanagement (Cyprus) underwent routine drydocking repairs at the shipyard. The repair scope included propeller repairs, hull painting, major steel renewal, renewal works on the vessel walkway, platform and hatch covers, as well as the installation of a Ballast Water Treatment System (BWTS).

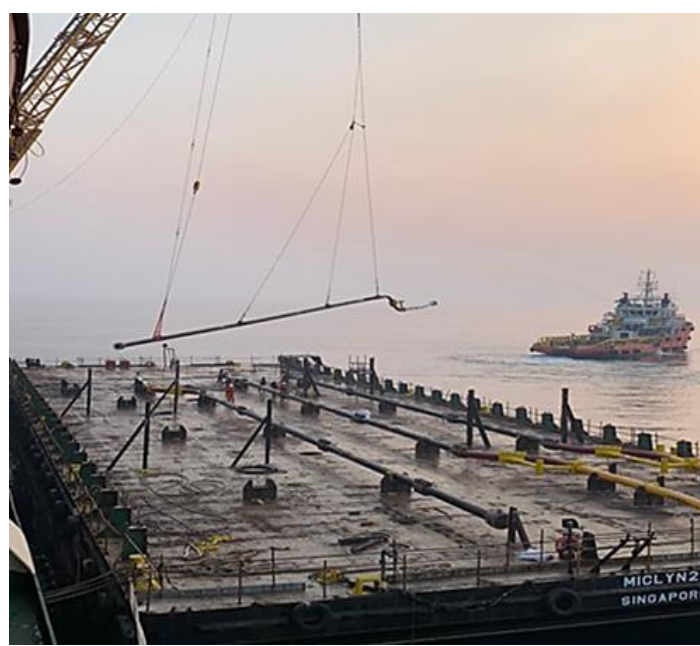
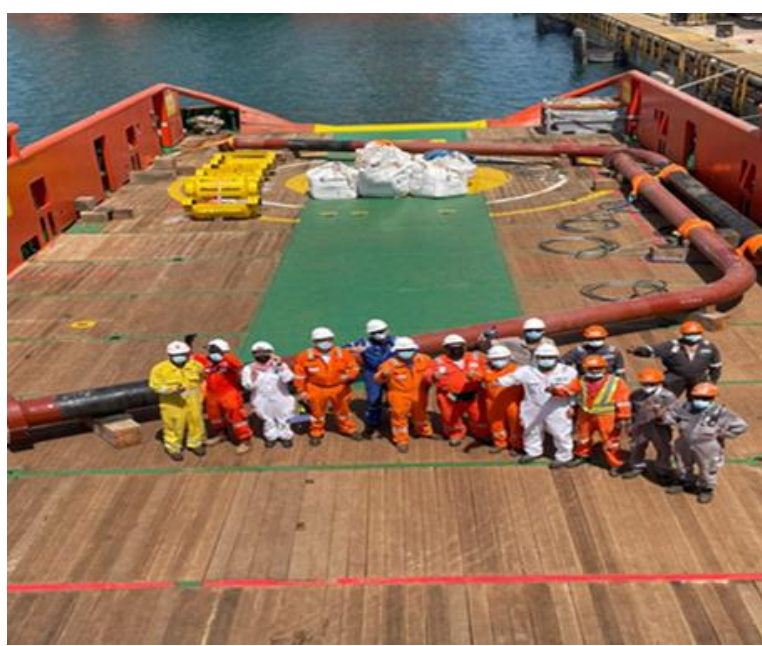

FABRICATION WORK FOR OFFSHORE PIPELINE PROJECT



N-KOM has completed fabrication work for the Total Al-Khalij SUMUD Offshore Pipeline project in Qatar. As part of the project, the yard provided project and safety management to Sapura Energy, in addition to construction base/facilities, quality control, construction engineering services and specialist manpower support. The fabrication, lifting, load-out and sail-away of risers and sub-sea spools have been completed in a safe and timely manner.

RIG REPAIRS SUCCESSFULLY DELIVERED

N-KOM has recently delivered a range of repairs, modification, equipment replacement and testing, platform fabrication works, general services and material load-out on various Seafox Rigs – Frontier, Matsu and Deema. The shipyard has delivered more than 90 repair and modification projects for jack-up rigs to date.
